Updates:

BCP Council have started to build test site for Health Local Offer. On the Level 2 tiles the term 'specialist services' was carried down from Level 1. We had a brief discussion on whether this was appropriate. Was carrying the term down necessary. There needs to be further discussion on this. Louise Chiles was asked to ensure that programmes that are no longer running are removed from BCP site (for example, the Incredible Years programme).

Dorset have a separate Family Info Directory and Local Offer site but are looking at how the two can be linked. Ian Bennett (now retired from DC) had been working with Louise Chiles to agree the tiles to ensure uniformity across both Local Offers.

Louise then shared the draft content for the tiles:

Main points raised:

- Many services have created online information during lockdown which was circulated to people on their caseload. This basic information could be included on the Local Offers.
- Need to ensure that adult services are linked into the local offer work.
- A working group should be set up to progress the transition to adulthood area of work.
- It was agreed that Local Authority Local Offers should be as consistent as possible. – We asked Louise Chiles to contact Laura White for information to be included under the Annual Health Checks Tile.
- The term ‘complex’ needs to be explained – different people, different interpretation.
- Mental Health 18+ tile – info needs to be shown in a graduated way – journey to be taken and what is available at what time including Steps to Wellbeing.
- Dyspraxia needs to be changed to Co-ordination Movement Disorder as this is the term being used.
- Need to review the order of the tiles – some will need to be changed.
- General information from Public Health England needs to be included in the Local Offer.
- Need to note what do families want or expect from the charities and support groups section of Local Offer. Links to specific conditions.
- Dynamic Risk Register & CETRs – what information needs to be included about them.
- Health Support in Education – this to be changed to Support for Children with Health Conditions in Education
- Personal Health Budgets
- LD/Autism Review, LD Nursing Teams and Adult LD Teams – what info is needed
- Sleep Issues – Melatonin

Actions:

LC will contact Laura White for info on: Annual Health Checks, LD/Autism Teams, LD Nursing Teams, the Dynamic Risk Register (although preferred name is Dynamic Support register). She will also look for information on funding for health.

CM will link with Continuing Care to review and update the information in this section

SC will provide information on sleep issues – Melatonin and will also speak with Sam Best re: timescales for some of the work of this group
