Previous minutes and actions agreed and updates concerning Alex Geen Cancer Screening a letter to be produced in an Easy Read version. However it was noted that for some understanding of any letters would be down to a third party. This letter will be sent in any Screening invites to assist and help figures improve by surgeries.

Continuing Healthcare: E/O raised a question who checks the work over?

LW said work was checked over by others and Personal Health Budgets were not available in Easy Read.A form will be developed and commented on by all Forums as part of Co-Production which LW stated she is keen to see in action.

Hazel gave a presentation on Continuing Healthcare but did not know the latest figures of those in hospital. On reaearch I can tell you there are 2 BCP and 5 Dorset with Learning Disabilities /Autism.

SL commented that low levels of understanding were worrying.

LW said the group will look at other forms as part of Co-Production.

Work continued on to the Yellow Health Books: firstly there was a reference to the red childrens book which is being phased out to an online version.





LW spoke of Plymouth's hospital online passport which seemed to work well (ongoing).

Evident that general awareness needs to be important around hospital admissions with information to hand available to all staff working with said patient a better understanding less stress for all concerned and all data to hand.

BC spoke on the Grab Sheet developed in Covid found at the front of Yellow Books.

A up to date patient history with diagnosis medication and any important factors to bear in mind when treating the patient.

GB work was ongoing on website to have all information to download forms etc nearly ready.
