Carers and lived experiences to add to plan alongside Suicides.

Dementia –will feature on next Agenda.

Big Plan of all ACTIONS –Plans are to be discussed with an update to other committees.

As part of the group work we were asked to choose our top 3 from a list of previous discussed issues of what we as a group would like to work on. From the list top 3 End of Life Transitions /PfA and Sex and Relationships. Pan Dorset working group info to include care planning across the Board. There are various pieces of work and the remainder of the list will be dealt with later as they are just as important.



There is a tool on website "THINKING AHEAD" for parents of children with LD.

Childrens Learning Disability Team CLDT works on Projects and Updates.

Work currently on All Age Autism in Dorset. We will hear from our LD liaison Nurses and their projects sadly not able to make meeting today.

Safe and Wellbeing Reviews: LOOK at Dynamic Support Register–those at risk A/LD launched Feb which will prioritise risk. These reviews will be finalised and completed and presented to the Integrated Care Panel which in turn figures go to NHS England. In the course of time we hopefully will see change and it will make a difference.

Next time we meet we will know where the 24 have gone in the Community.

Safe and Wellbeing reviews panel meets March 8th to sign off. So come June the LDPB and Health Scrutiny Board will feedback to HAG in June.

Communications Board Actions- a report on what they are doing better?

Plus how many new people are in Specialist Hospitals distinguishing the patients groups.

Safe and Wellbeing currently have 18 Dorset patients. Includes child and adults and specialist needs.

Children/yp to 18 yrs =3 and 15 Adults are currently on the Dynamic Support Register. Concerns around the criteria CCG Team oversee Register. Accessibility needs more definition to all GB will link all using the same info.

LEDER EASY READ REPORT –aims 3 out of 4 Annual Health Checks to be completed. There is now an 8 week plan/directive to boost AHC figs. Future project for 2022 is to get more understanding to teenagers about the importance of this work.

Action Plans to be written for YELLOW HEALTH BOOKS and COVID.

Bowel and Cancer screening needs more information update at next meeting.

Within the AHC toolkit there is a part that feeds back the quality of the check time taken action plan etc.
