Performance and Quality Assurance Commentary

Emerging Trends

- EHCPs numbers are continuing to increase and it is anticpated that this upward trend is to continue. Local trend mirrors national trend.

- Increasing EHCP assessment requests and EHCP

- SEND Mainstream banding review roll out is planned for September 2022, this will impact the spend on EHCPs - it is anticipated that initially costs will increase however, data modelling is underway and when available it is anticipated that a timeframe for when BCP can expect to see a positive impact on the High Needs Budget will be illustrated.

What the data is telling us (potential areas of concern)

- Timeliness - 6 wk timeframe of decision to proceed with an assessment of needs - %'s are extremely low

- Timeliness - EHCP Assessments completions exceeding 20wk timescale - well below the 60% target

- Increasing numbers of EHCP requests and its impact on timeliness of assessment completion within 20wk timeframe

- Of the 6 audits undertaken each month we are consistently below our target of 75% for judged as good/outstanding
