In June 2021 Ofsted and the Care Quality Commission inspected the SEND provision in Bournemouth Christchurch and Poole.

The inspectors found 8 'significant areas of weakness'.

BCP Council has responded with a 'Written Statement of Action' which has 70 actions to address these 8 improvement areas.

The Council is being monitored by the Department for Education and there will be a re-inspection in 2023 or 2024.

Parent Carers Together Position Statement

- PCT was sad, but not surprised that BCP failed its Ofsted inspection.
- PCT is engaged in coproduction with BCP Council and with NHS Dorset, to ensure the voice of SEND parents is heard.
- PCT representatives were involved in preparing the Written Statement of Action, and we are currently involved in meetings to progress these actions across all improvement areas.
- PCT is disappointed that many of the improvement actions are already severely delayed compared to the planned timescales
- PCT believes that BCP Council leaders should be accountable to deliver SEND improvements in a timely way.

Parent Carers Together Objectives

- PCT works to influence BCP Council and NHS Dorset to improve the quality of all SEND services
- PCT is pushing for outcomes from this action plan that will result in tangible positive effects for children with SEND and their families.
